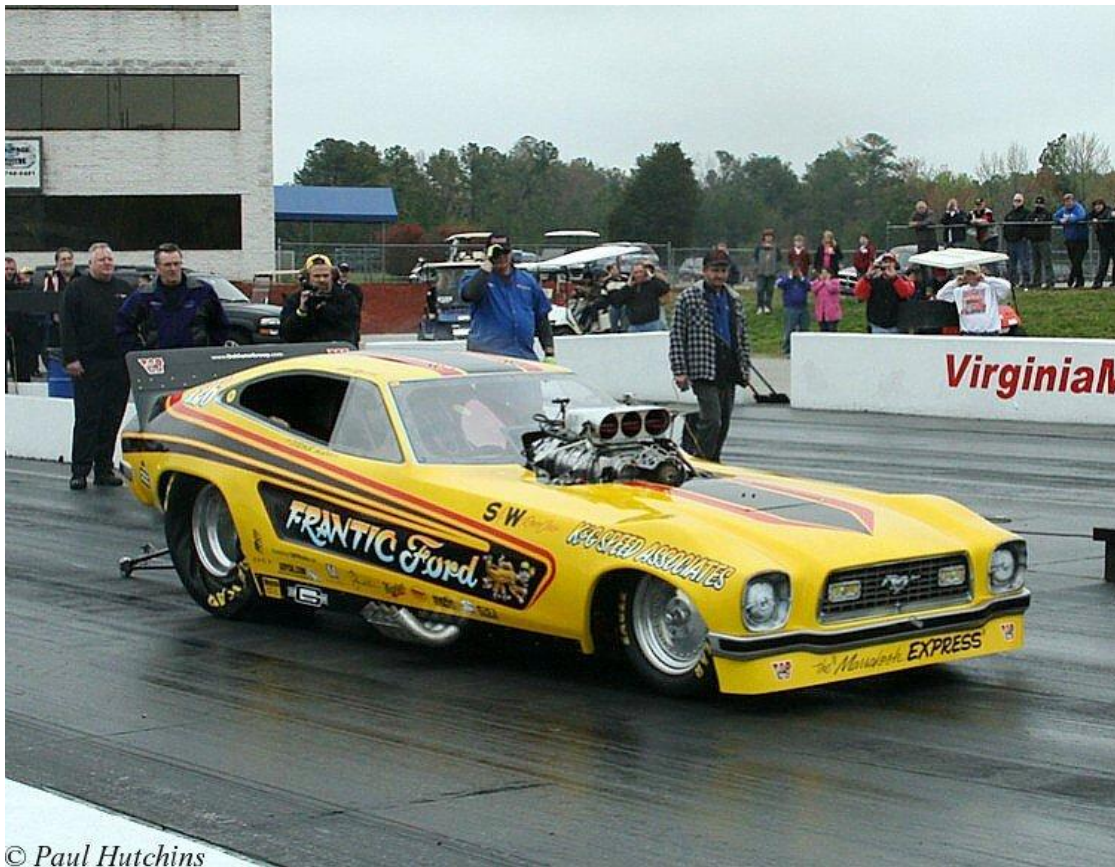

**The Frantic Ford Funny Car Team has been busy the past few weeks with preseason testing of the 1977 Mustang II bodied car**

### **April 9-10th - "Best of Times Nationals" (Virginia Motorsports Park) - 1977 Mustang II BB/FC**

The team headed south with the Mustang II bodied machine to conduct a preseason "test 'n' tune" session with the new powerplant. Despite cold weather conditions and a slippery track surface, driver George Reidnauer was able to pilot the freshly assembled car to successful passes on both qualifying attempts. Track and weather conditions dictated that the team place a mild tune-up in the motor as to not overpower the racing surface. Both passes were in the low 7 second range at close to 190 mph. When qualifying was completed, George placed the Mustang II in the third quickest position among the competitors in attendance. As only the two quickest cars from qualifying would return for a two car final round appearance, it was time to pack up and head back to the shop with the data we collected from our first successful outing.

With the potent powerplant combination we have in place and the strong marketing support behind us, we look to have the Frantic Ford Mustang II running in the mid to upper 6 second range at close to 200 mph in the very near future. The next performance related appearance for the car is slated to take place on Sun. May 1 at Atco Raceway.
